Scholarship Requirements

To be eligible for the Southside Church of Christ scholarship, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Currently attending and active participant at Southside Church of Christ
- Baptized member of Southside Church of Christ, Seattle, WA.
- Eligible to graduate with high school diploma, GED or equivalent at time of application
- Passion to pursue higher education post high school
- Involved with at least one extracurricular, civic, community activity, work, hobby while in high school

Eligible Use of Scholarship Funds

Award must be used for school-related expenses such as, but not limited to: Tuition, books, Supplies, Lab Fees, etc.

Application Process Timeline

Applications must be postmarked no later than May 28, 2025. Scholarship finalist will be notified by email regarding the mandatory virtual interview the week of June 1, 2025 (4pm).

SCOC Scholarship Application Packet Guidelines (NEW APPLICANTS)

- 1) Completed Application Form
- 2) Transcript mailed by student's school directly to SCOC
- 3) Enrollment Verification
- 4) Submit three (3) letters of recommendations describing your character and potential from the following individuals:
 - a) Member of Southside Church of Christ
 - b) Current school teacher
 - c) Former teacher, counselor, minister, coach, employer, community activity leader
- 5) Letter of interest/essay detailing what the student hopes to achieve in the next step of their academic career, how they would benefit from the award, and how they've contributed to the church. How might you use your talents/skills to encourage/influence others to become a Christian. Please list three places you would like a gift card from. Must be no more than 2 pages max, typed, double spaced, 12 pt. font.
